Quad City International Airport Update

Ben Leischner, Executive Director of the Metropolitan Airport Authority of Rock Island County, provided an overview of the Quad City International Airport. The Authority employs 55 workers, and another 30 are employed with the service arm of the organization for ground services support. The authority's 8 commissioners oversee \$250 million in assets and facilities.

Destinations. The airport offers 11 non-stop destinations including Chicago O'Hare, Detroit, Minneapolis/St. Paul, Atlanta, St. Pete/Clearwater, Orlando-Sanford, Punta Gorda, Dallas/Fort Worth, Denver, Phoenix-Mesa, and Las Vegas. Air carriers include Allegiant Air, American, Delta, and United Airlines.

Economic Impact. Mr. Leischner spoke on the value the airport brings to the community, including over 500 direct jobs, and a total annual economic impact of over 4,000 jobs. The total annual economic output is nearly \$500 million. In the upcoming construction season, there is over \$5.1 million in scheduled improvements equivalent to over 100 prevailing wage jobs to contractors and sub-contractors.

Improvements. Planned improvements total \$34 million from 2019 to 2024. The airport authority is looking to make terminal façade improvements, updates to the lobby and ticketing area, and signage and wayfinding upgrades in FY2020. This work will help establish a Quad Cities associated identity and increase customer service.

Other objectives to work toward include developing complimentary air service destinations, improved schedules and marketing the airport globally to bring businesses into the region. He concluded by touching on the Fly Local Alliance (Look Before You Book) which encourages travelers to use the True-Cost Trip Calculator on the airport's website: <https://www.qcairport.com/trip>

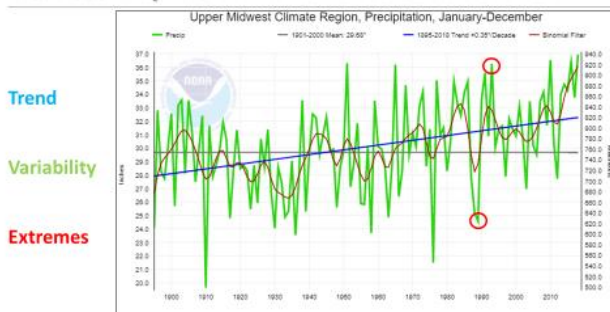


Weather and Climate Resilience – Are We Ready?

Ray Wolf, Science and Operations Officer with the National Weather Service (NWS), under the parent agency National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), provided an overview on weather and climate resilience. With a mission of a “Weather-Ready Nation,” the NWS provides weather, water, and climate forecasts and warnings for the protection of life and property, and for the enhancement of the national economy. Hazards planning and preparedness is core to this mission.

Climate vs. Weather. Climate is what you expect while weather is what you get. Weather records demonstrate variability and extremes, while climate is a trend over time. He illustrated this with a graph on annual precipitation for the upper Midwest with the precipitation trend increasing between 1900 and 2010 from 28 inches to 32 inches annually. This change represents an increase of 1/3 per inch over a decade, and has contributed to a 28% increase in flow of the Mississippi River. Understanding that climate change is occurring and the science behind these trends is critical for planning and preparedness as part of community resilience strategies.

Variability vs. Trend and Extremes

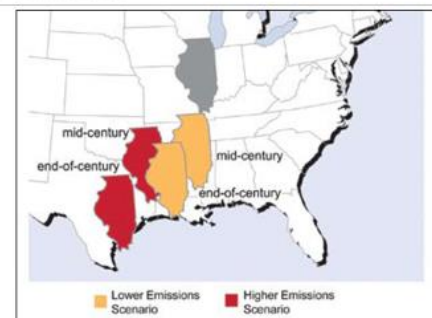

Disasters' Impacts. In 2018 alone, there were 14 separate billion-dollar weather and climate disasters in the United States. Between 1980 and 2019, the average trend has escalated from less than one to more than six per year on average. In 2011, there were 16 disasters. Resilience has significant economic importance as well as social component of affected citizens. Urban areas with their redundant facilities tend to be more resilient than rural areas where there are fewer roads and resources. As well-demonstrated this past winter and spring, winter storms interrupted travel, and resulted in higher costs for snow removal. Increased frequency of freeze-thaw cycles affecting road surfaces are evidenced by potholes and poor pavement conditions. Record flooding affected bridges and culverts and closed roads. Mr. Wolf noted that Bi-State staff are working on a metropolitan extreme weather transportation resilience pilot that will help bring attention to these issues.

Future Climate and Strategies. Our future climate is predicted to be similar to the climate of our most southern states using lower emission and higher emission scenarios. The illustration below highlights this probability for mid-century to end-of-century forecasts for the State of Illinois. As an example of best practices, the NWS office in Davenport is powered by 40% renewable energy. Other national and local air emission reduction efforts will help to contribute to the slowing of climate trends. Collaborating for Community Health: The Quad City Health Initiative

The Quad City Health Initiative was formed in 1999 and is celebrating 20 years of cross-community partnerships to create a healthy community. Nicole Carkner, QCHI Executive Director, spoke about engaging a variety of sectors across organizational and geographic boundaries to improve community health. There are 13 health opportunity areas, such as disease, oral health, tobacco use, and injury/violence. Priorities include nutrition, physical activity and weight, mental health, and access to healthcare.

Community Health Assessment. Occurring every 3 years and dating back to 2002, a systematic, data-driven assessment of health status, behaviors, and needs is conducted in Muscatine, Scott, and Rock Island Counties to provide a barometer on residents' health and wellness. The outlook compares the area with the U.S. on a variety of indicators. As an example, 79.9% were identified in the 2018 assessment at overweight (BMI 25+), compared to the U.S. percentage of 67.8%.

A working group of the QCHI, Be Healthy QC is helping to provide opportunities to increase physical activity and healthy eating. Be Healthy QC has supported workplace wellness initiatives, promotion of www.QCTrails.org, the Be Healthy QC educational campaign, and information sharing on access to healthy foods. The QCTrails interactive website has expanded to include trails in Henry County, and trails are being added for Muscatine County.

Quad Cities Behavioral Health Coalition. A group of 50 community partners convened in April 2019 to support community behavioral health in Scott and Rock Island Counties. A primary function of the coalition is to promote awareness and to tell the community story related to behavioral health. Other functions include measuring coalition progress, providing a platform for innovation, and increasing resources. The coalition intends to connect with other existing groups, such as the Quad Cities Trauma Informed Consortium, and be involved with QCHI and United Way.

Other Health Focus Areas. Ms. Carkner noted other QCHI efforts include a partnership with Tobacco-Free QC to address reducing the impact of tobacco in the Quad Cities. Information on tobacco, second-hand smoke, tobacco-free policies, and smoke-free pledges are part of the outreach effort.

In collaboration with St. Ambrose's Institute for Person-Centered Care, QCHI is a partner along with area health systems as the Institute provides for continuing education and support and leadership to foster person-centered models of care. Lastly, she noted a partnership with Live Lead Free QC initiative to raise awareness and reduce lead-based paint in area housing.
