1. Call Meeting to Order. Mr. Heninger called the meeting to order welcoming all those in attendance. On behalf of the Council, he thanked Mr. Nelson for the tour of Schwiebert Riverfront Park that preceded the meeting.
2. Approval of the May 25, 2010 Quad City Riverfront Council (QCRFC) meeting minutes. Mr. Grimes made a motion to approve the minutes as written. The motion was seconded by Mr. Taylor. The minutes were approved as written.
3. Individual Riverfront Reports –

*Rock Island* – Mr. Nelson reminded the Council of the Floatzilla event to be held on August 21, 2010.

*Princeton* – Ms. Grunder announced Princeton Days will be held on August 27-29, 2010.

*River Action* – Ms. Wine distributed brochures for the Upper Mississippi River Conference and posters for Floatzilla. Volunteers and participants are needed for Foatzilla. She encouraged participants to bring kayaks and/or canoes. Currently ,there are under 200 registered for the event, and 1700 linked vessels are needed to break the world record. A national marketing campaign has been launched for the event. The Council discussed staging and other specifics related to Floatzilla.

*Modern Woodman* – Mr. Doyle mentioned Ya-Maka my weekend is August 13 and 14, 2010.

4. Next Meeting – Tuesday, July 27, 2010 – Topics suggested for future meetings included:
  - Update on construction plans for the I-74 bridge
  - Overview from the Corps on new flood response methods
