1. Approval of Minutes of the August 22, 2017 Transportation Policy Committee. Mayor Klipsch called the meeting to order and asked for approval of the minutes. Mr. Ambrose motioned for approval of the August 22, 2017 minutes of the Transportation Policy Committee as written. Mr. Dawson seconded, and the motion carried.
2. Consideration of the Amendments to the FFY 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Mr. Melton reviewed the amendments and administrative modifications received from Illinois and Iowa Departments of Transportation, City of Davenport/Citibus, Moline, and Rock Island County. Revisions to the TIP are attached to these minutes. A handout was distributed with updated information from those sent in the agenda packet. Mr. Ambrose motioned to approve the FFY 2018-21 Transportation Improvement Program amendments as presented in the meeting. Mr. O’Boyle seconded the motion, which carried. Administrative modifications were presented for information.
3. Presentation on Complete Streets Year 2 – Sidewalk Policies and Non-Motorized Transportation. Mrs. McCullough provided an overview of the Complete Streets initiative under Iowa Department of Public Health and Illinois State Metropolitan Planning Grants and explained the broader efforts for continued work during the second year of the grant. Mr. Soliz provided information concerning

the current status of the project, outlining which Scott County member governments had existing sidewalk policies and two smaller member governments volunteering for technical assistance with developing a sidewalk inventory (Eldridge and LeClaire). Similar information will be collected in Rock Island County, as well as Muscatine County. Having this information will provide a good foundation for the next long range transportation plan update, as well as support livability initiatives. It was noted that sidewalk assessments and development of sidewalk policies would be done for Eldridge and LeClaire as part of the grant scope of work.

4. Public Comments. None
5. Other Business. Mr. Litteral with Federal Highway Administration was introduced and noted information on freight funding. Mayor Klipsch announced his appointment to the Mississippi River and Towns Initiative as a Co-Chair with Mayor Lionel Johnson of St. Gabriel, Louisiana. (Mayor Gallagher is on the Executive Committee). The Quad Cities will be hosting the 2018 MRCTI conference. Mayor Acri announced a public meeting on I-74 set for October 30 at the Moline Police Station, and referenced a speakers' bureau on the project website. There was also discussion on next priorities after the I-74 bridge is reconstructed and how the other road and rail bridge needs will be addressed. Bi-State staff will begin discussions via the Mississippi River bridge coordination group. The Policy Committee also requested cyclical updates on the I-74 project.
6. Adjournment. Mayor Klipsch asked for a motion to adjourn. Mr. Ambrose made the motion, and it was seconded by Ms. Tompkins. The meeting was adjourned by consensus at 12:30 p.m.
