Consideration of the Surface Transportation Program (STP) Evaluation Process Candidate Projects for Project Selection (The STP Evaluation Process Response Forms for Bettendorf (1), Davenport (8), East Moline (2), Eldridge (1), Moline (3), Rock Island (9), Rock Island County (1) will be e-mailed to Technical Committee members prior to the meeting. The estimated amounts of STP funds to be programmed through FFY2019 are \$4.15 million in Illinois Quad Cities and \$5.34 million in the Iowa Quad Cities. The total candidate projects' costs amount to \$26.98 in the Illinois Quad Cities and \$47.97 million in the Iowa Quad Cities.
