1. Approval of the Minutes of the August 8, 2017 Transportation Technical Committee Meeting.
Mr. Morlok requested a motion for approval of the August 8, 2017 minutes of the Transportation Technical Committee. Mr. Schadt motioned to approve the minutes as written. Mr. Hinton seconded the motion, and it carried. Ms. McCullough noted that there was not a quorum and actions would be ratified at the next Technical Committee meeting.
2. Status of Project Progress Report. Mr. Melton reported that the Forest Grove Road project was nearly complete. He reported no other major changes and requested that members continue to send updates and to provide the status of projects in the FFY2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program for document development. 3. Consideration of the Amendments to the FFY 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Mr. Melton provided an overview of the amendments to the FFY 2018-2021 TIP. The amendments concerned changes in funding pertaining to five Illinois Department of Transportation projects, one Rock Island County project, one project from the City of Davenport, three from Davenport CitiBus, and one project from the Iowa Department of Transportation. Refer to the TIP Revisions attached to these minutes. The tables with associated funding levels are at the end of these minutes. Mr. Schadt motioned to recommend the amendments for approval by the Transportation Policy Committee. Mr. Hinton seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

4. Presentation on Complete Streets Year 2 – Sidewalk Policies and Non-motorized Transportation Efforts. Mrs. McCullough provided an overview of the Complete Streets initiative under Iowa Department of Public Health and Illinois State Metropolitan Planning Grants and explained the broader efforts for continued work during the second year of the grant. Mr. Soliz provided information concerning the current status of the project, outlining which Scott County member governments had existing sidewalk policies and two smaller member governments volunteering for technical assistance with developing a sidewalk inventory (Eldridge and LeClaire). Similar information will be collected in Rock Island County, as well as Muscatine County. Having this information will provide a good foundation for the next Long Range Transportation Plan update, as well as support livability initiatives. There was some discussion on ADA compliance related to this agenda item.
5. Public Comments. None.
6. Other Business. Mr. DeLille noted that the ILDOT Long Range Transportation Plan is currently being reviewed internally, with a final draft being released in December 2017. He noted the status of the state rail and freight plans. The Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program grants solicitation is open through December 1 and will require communities to be registered through the GATA grants accountability process for administration of the funds. Mr. Shea noted the trading of Iowa Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) funds allocated to the RPAs/MPOs for STBG to address federal requirements of competitive process and allowing local programming ability. An I-80 Study is underway in Eastern Iowa and open for comments. The IADOT is starting the NEPA process on I-80 capacity/safety improvements, which is expected to take 12-18 months.
7. Adjournment. Mr. Schadt motioned to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Hinton seconded, and the meeting was adjourned at 10:40 a.m.
